HEALTH ATTESTATION

It is hereby officially certified that:

1. In connection with the export of hides/skins, animals slaughtered in approved slaughter establishments are subject to ante-mortem and post mortem inspection to determine freedom from clinical signs of infectious and contagious disease by a Government veterinary inspector.
2. Ireland is free from foot-and-mouth disease (FMD). There has been no outbreak of FMD, Rinderpest or African Swine Fever for the past 2 years prior to shipment of the hides and skins.
3. If the exporting country is affected by one of the following diseases - FMD, Rinderpest or African Swine Fever:
 - a) These hides/skins have been under salt which includes 2% sodium carbonate for at least 28 days prior to shipment and have been kept separate after treatment from untreated hides and skins and the necessary measures have been taken for the prevention of contamination of the treated skins from FMD. Or,
 - b) Soaking with agitation for at least 48 hours in an alkaline solution of pH 11.5 or above, such as 4% (w/v) solution of sodium carbonate. Or,
 - c) Soaking with agitation for at least 48 hours in an acid solution of below pH 3.0 such as a formic acid solution (100kg salt [NaCl] and 12kg formic acid per 1,000 litres water.
